<p><u>BOOKTIME IN RECEPTION</u></p> <p>Every Friday families are invited to join the class for Booktime. Please come at 3pm and share some stories with your child in class. Encourage your child to write lists of rhyming words and make sure they can identify the pattern.</p> <p>We are also writing I like...I can....I went....I am...sentences.</p> <p>Always let your child use a wide range of writing tools including chalks, a biro, felt pens and pencils.</p>	<p><u>PHONICS</u></p> <p><u>We will learn all these phase 3 sounds this term.</u></p> <p>j, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, ai, ee, ie, oa, oo, ar, or, ow, oi, ear, oi, air, ure, er</p> <p>As you can see they are a lot trickier than the phase 2 sounds! All these sounds have actions too so ask your child to show you how.</p>
<p><u>MATHS CHALLENGE</u></p> <p>Encourage your child to count on and back along their 1-20 numberline.</p> <p>Do they know the names of all the numbers?</p> <p>Can they have a go at writing them in the correct order?</p> <p>When talking about the written number system please call 1,2,3,4,.....digits as that is how we refer to them in school.</p> <p>For example say "What digits can you see in our phone number/on our door/on our car number plate?"</p>	<p><u>READING</u></p> <p>We really value your support at home with reading and your child will make faster progress in all areas of their learning.</p> <p>Book time is at 3pm every Friday and everyone is welcome.</p> <p>Please remember to send your child's book bag to school every day.</p> 	<p><u>WEBTASTIC!
