WRITING

We are learning to write lots of high frequency words. Please help your child practise these at home.

We are also writing, I like...I can....I went....I am...sentences.

Encourage your child to write about the things that interest them, e.g. minibeasts, their fascinations, labels on their models.....

Always let your child use a wide range of writing tools including chalks, a biro, felt pens and pencils.

PHONICS

We have learnt all these phase 3 sounds.

J, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, ai, ee, ie, oa, oo, ar, or, ow, oi, ear, oi, air, ure, er

We are also learning a-e, as in cake, make, bake.....which is even trickier!

All these sounds have actions too so ask your child to show you how.

Your child needs to practise these sounds often so please use the flash cards at home.

Encourage them to write them in words too, like oa in boat, ee in sheep, air in chair, ear in hear.

MATHS CHALLENGE

Encourage your child to count on and back along a 1-20 number line.

Do they know the names of all the numbers?

Can they have a go at writing them in the correct order?

We are learning number bonds to 10, so 1+9=10, 2+8+10, 3+7=10 and so on.

We are learning doubles like, 1+1, 2+2, 3+3, 4+4, 5+5. We are also learning what half of a group of objects is and how to share these between two people. Have some maths fun using your child's toys, lego or even peas on the plate!

READING

We are introducing comprehension questions to book group time. Ask your child some questions about the book.

This will help them to explain their thinking just like the Explainer.
