Prime Area: Personal, Social and Emotional development (PSED)

<u>PSHE</u> Children will learn to respect the differences and similarities between people and find out about different ways of life.

Children will learn that there are lots of different jobs and that these jobs can be for men and women. We want to invite parents and family members to come and talk to the children about the jobs they do or the skills they have.

Children will learn that people and other living things have needs and that we all have responsibilities to meet them.

Specific Area: Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

Children will create art and make models in response to real life experiences.

Children will explore sound, music, dance and movement and have weekly music lessons.

Children will experiment with paint, collage, malleable and other materials.

Children will learn songs in class and with Year 1 and Year 2 in assemblies and shared learning events.

Prime Area: Communication and Language (CL)

<u>Speaking</u> – Children will talk about class stories and rhymes. They will talk about fiction and non-fiction books about owls and other animals. They will learn lots of clapping rhymes and songs.

<u>Listening</u> - Children will listen to many different stories, songs and rhymes.

<u>Understanding</u> – Children will play games/ask questions/answer questions/express their ideas

Children will play and follow the rules of a range of games.

Specific Area: Understanding the World (UW)

Children can bring in a special object from home and talk about it to the class.

Children will find out about natural materials by exploring the environment outdoors.

Children will plant bulbs/seeds and take part in gardening activities.

Prime Area: Physical Development (PD)

Children will continue to develop good handwriting skills in class lessons and small groups.
