

## Prime Area: Personal, Social and Emotional development (PSED)

SEAL New Beginnings. Play circle games/name games and make friends.

## Specific Area: Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

Experiment with paint, collage, malleable and other materials.

## Specific Area: Understanding the World (UW)

Learn about owls and other animals that live in Britain. Find out about Autumn and notice the changes that take place in the natural world.

Learn about our families, our friends' families and where they come from. Develop an awareness of belonging to a community, in class, in school, in Brighton, and in Britain.

## Specific Area: Literacy

## Specific Area: Mathematics (M)
