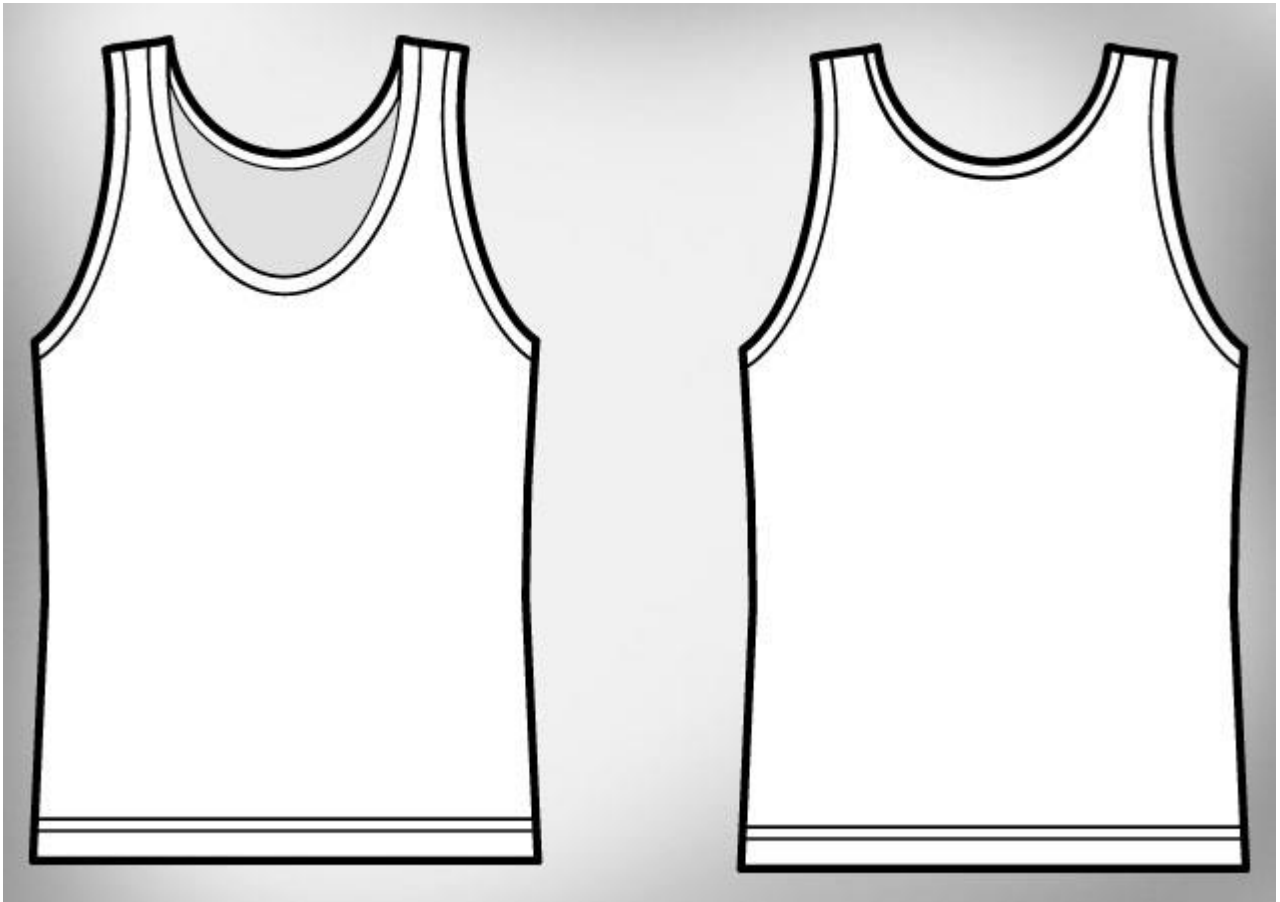
Good luck and keep in touch! We look forward to seeing what you have all been up to.
