Thank you for all your support and kind messages over the last 4 months. It's been a very strange time for everybody but for some, I know, it has been very difficult.

For children who are currently in school, term finishes on Wednesday 22nd July. School WILL NOT be open for childcare over the summer. Unfortunately, many providers are not able to open, due to the very short notice they were given regarding re-opening.

Food Bank

Over the summer, we will open our food bank once a week for you to collect food if you need it. Currently it is well stocked, so please don't hesitate to pop in. We will send a Ping before the end of term to let you know when it will be open.

Transition

As far as we know, school will re-open to all pupils in Years 1-6 on Monday 7th September. Children in our new Reception will be given their own start dates. If needed, we will be in touch before then about any additional arrangements that may be put in place, such as staggered start times. Before the end of term, each teacher will send a transition task to all of the children in their new class. This is something they can work on over the summer.
