Prime Area: Personal, Social and Emotional development

Specific Area: Expressive Arts and Design

Children will create art and make models in response to real life experiences. Children will explore sound, music, dance and movement and enjoy drama and role play as pirates and explorers.

Specific Area: Understanding the World

Children will find out all about growing plants.

Children will find out about natural materials by exploring the environment outdoors and taking part in loose parts play.

Children will learn about minibeasts.

Children will visit the Dome for the Reception Celebration Event.

Children will take part in sports day.

Prime Area: Physical Development

Children will continue to develop good handwriting skills.

Children will take part in healthy cooking and eating activities.

Children will take part in weekly PE lessons.

Specific Area: Literacy

Children will take part in Pie Corbett talk for writing activities and perform their stories in front of an audience.

We will learn the story of The Little Red Hen.

We will learn the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We will learn to write our own stories and fact books about minibeasts and growing plants.

Children will consolidate the Phase 3/4 phonemes and learn phase 5 spelling patterns.

Children will learn to write simple captions and sentences

Specific Area: Mathematics

Children will take part in daily maths activities to learn about counting, matching, ordering, sorting skills both inside and outside.

We will use number to 20 and begin to solve problems using addition and subtraction methods. Children will learn that mathematics is used in real life situations. We will learn number bonds to 10, understand doubles and how to find half of a group of objects and share them with a friend.
