Social Communication Resource and Serenity School

We currently have 2 other provisions working with our school. The Social Communication Resource is a provision for children who are, or are likely to be, diagnosed with autism and are struggling to attend mainstream school. Children come in on a part time basis, usually with staff from their mainstream school, to work through any barriers with the experts running the provision. I am on the steering group and panel for the SCR so I am kept up to date with developments and regularly consulted. The Local Authority pay us a small rent for the space

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but also refurbished the community room at no cost to us. They have been with is for over a year now and are very much part of our school community.

Serenity School is a school for children with Special Educational Needs, currently based in Croydon but opening a new site in Crawley. Since early October, they have been renting our spare classroom for their Brighton-based pupils whilst they are waiting for their new school to be built. They are likely to be here until Christmas and again, are very much part of our school community.
