## **Topic Tasks**

Day 1 - 22/10– PSHE - Complete one of the 3 reading comprehensions on Martin Luther King (the  $2^{nd}$  one is harder but is much more interesting)

Day 2 - 23/10 -Science - Make your own slime using the Awe and Wonder worksheet. All you need is cornflour and food dye.

- 1. What happens when you pick the slime up, squeeze it or even punch or slap it?
- 2. Do you think it is a solid or a liquid?
- 3. How is it different to water?

Don't forget to wear an apron or old clothes. Ask an adult for permission before you begin!

Day 3-2/11- Art - Create a family portrait. Choose a family member and use the art activity sheet to guide you in how to draw an accurate sketch of a face. It gives great tips on how to create a realistic drawing! Did you know, for example, that eyes should be placed halfway up the face?
