Dear Parents and Carers,

Summer Term Clubs

Before the pandemic, we had a very successful club programme. Over the summer term, we are going to run a few clubs with the hope that there will be more in the next academic year. Apologies for the late notice regarding these clubs – we are trying to get used to the system again!

Clubs will begin running next week and this letter hopefully contains all the information you should need. Please see the attached Club Options sheet which tells you all about the clubs that are available over the Summer Term. Please look carefully at the dates and times of each club and note these in your diary as soon as you have booked your club. **Not all clubs run every week** due to staff training, room availability and other school events. If your child is here for a club that doesn't run, you will be charged for their child care at a cost of £10 per hour or part hour.

Clubs must be booked and paid for through ParentPay. Payment has to be made in full at the time of booking and cannot be made through the school office – ParentPay only please. If your child attended Textiles club just before the pandemic, the club will be available for them ONLY to book at first – after that, any remaining places will be opened up to other children in Year 5 and Year 6.

You will only be able to book and pay for a club if spaces are available so once you have paid, you are guaranteed a space in a school-led club. For external-led clubs (cricket club and dance club), you need to sign up using the instructions on the information sheet and wait for confirmation from the club provider before paying on ParentPay. Please do not ask staff to consider an additional child for the club – numbers are decided for a range of reasons, including child safety.

The clubs vary in price. Some clubs are run by outside providers who decide their own costs and most of these are currently subsidised using our Sports Fund. Teachers run clubs as part of their role in school. Support staff, such as Teaching Assistants, are paid extra to run clubs and this is included in the costs. The cost of clubs also covers any equipment and resources that are required. Any profit made from clubs will be added to school fund and used for school resources. If your child would be interested in attending a club that is run by school staff but there are financial reasons that prevent them attending, please contact me via the school office ASAP.

If your child has an EHCP and requires additional support in class, please contact Rachel Christie-Davies BEFORE you sign your child up to a club, so appropriate arrangements can be made.
